The Owner further represents that he will not be in violation of any regulations or restrictions imposed by any Country of Municipal agency or by any deed restrictions which may be attached to the property and that any required variance has been secured. The District assumes no responsibility for, and the Owner will hold the District harmless from, disputes of title, rights, or liability for damages to persons or property arising from the construction maintenance or existence of such improvements. At any time the condition or presence of this improvement interferes with the operation of the reservoir or the safety of the persons or property using the surface thereof, the Owner agrees to immediately make any and all changes or corrections necessary to make the improvement comply with the General Ordinance or remove the improvement from District property at the Owner's expense.

By acceptance of the subsequent permit, you hereby release and discharge Tarrant Regional Water District and its agents, and directors, and agree that Tarrant Regional Water District shall not be held liable or responsible for, and shall be indemnified and held harmless by, you, your successors, assigns, and heirs, from and against any and all claims and damages of every kind for injury indirect, to operation, use, or existence, of the improvement which you are requesting permission to construct on the District's Reservoir, or from any act of the District, its agents, or directors, including the operation BASED IN WHOLE OR IN PART ON THE ALLEGED NEGLIGENCE OR OTHER TORT OF TARRANT REGIONAL WATER DISTRICT OR ITS AGENTS OR DIRECTORS, THE PARTIES HERETO INTENDING TO THE EXPRESS NEGLIGENCE DOCTRINE.

This release and indemnification shall survive termination or expiration of the permit.
